

Enabling Works and Meet the Builder Event

Dear Residents,

We are making good progress on site and are now focusing on the external service routes around the site, allowing us to distribute the new services to each of the new buildings. This work is extensive within the Univ site and allows us to connect to the new substation scheduled to be built on Banbury Road later in the year. We will provide more details in forthcoming notifications. The Banbury Road side of the site is also well established with our delivery team now housed in the site offices.

On the Staverton Road side of the site, we are continuing with the Garden House preparations for deconstruction, including some works to retain the building perimeter walls and enhancements to the underground structure. We foresee that these adaptations will continue to take place over the next couple of months before the deconstruction of the current Garden House. Once this is complete, the work for rebuilding will take place, creating the new nursery.

We are also scheduling an open evening for local residents, you are very welcome to come and meet the SDC team and learn more about the project.
