

Graphics, Garden House Alterations, and a Groundbreaking Event

Dear Residents,

We have now completed the demolition works and the creation of the new main site delivery routes. We hope this didn't cause you too much disruption. We are now well underway with the installation of the foundations and drainage for the new buildings, and this work will continue over the next few months in readiness for the above groundworks to commence later in the year.

As you may have seen, the decorative graphics on the Banbury Road side of the site have been installed, telling the University College, Oxford's (Univ) story to the public and the wider community. Our site offices have also been established on the Banbury Road side and will house our project delivery team.

Our works remain within the Univ North site on the Staverton Road side, and here we have commenced the installation of foundations and drainage for the new nursery. In the coming weeks, we will begin the alterations to the existing Garden House to rebuild the nursery itself. As the work starts, SDC will install traffic marshals within Staverton Road to manage the traffic movements to and from the site.
