Information Update from University College, Oxford and Construction Partner, SDC

Although we are nearing the end of January, this is our first newsletter of 2025 and so we would like to wish you a Happy New Year. We are looking forward to maintaining the cordial and cooperative relationship that we have built with yourselves.

2025 will be a big year for the project as the first buildings in the scheme are handed over to the College with our teams on site working hard to deliver this on time. The second half of the year will also see the commencement of the CLT (cross laminated timber) frame to the final building still to be erected, Banbury Road Villa.

On the Banbury Road side of the site works are progressing well and preparatory groundworks and service ducts for the Villa have started. Walnut Lawn Villa has now reached the stage where we are starting the internal fit out, and the façade works which includes the roof and brick cladding is continuing.

Both Water Court West and East are getting closer to completion internally, and the facades are also progressing at a good rate. By the end of the month, 'Sparkle' the tower crane will be removed from the site, allowing the works to the

Rill (water feature) to start, which will finally bring the design together within this area. It will be a shame to see the crane go, as it has become a familiar part of the North Oxford skyline over the last 18 months, although we are pleased that some of the Nursery children involved in the naming were able to visit the site last summer and see Sparkle in action!

It hasn't all been smooth sailing as we have been hindered by the very cold temperatures experienced earlier in the month meaning that some of our external works had to be paused. The biggest consequence of this has been on the brick facades as we can only lay bricks when the temperature goes above 5 degrees to prevent the moisture in the mortar freezing before it has set.

On the Staverton road side, again the works are progressing.

As previously stated, the Nursery is practically complete with the final M&E (Mechanical & Electrical) systems being commissioned under The external hard temporary power. landscaping is also heading towards completion.

Woodstock Pavillion is now virtually weather tight with the roof covering and nearly all windows installed. This releases US to commence the internal fit out.
